This course is designed for students interested in pursuing a career in the Automotive Industry. A strong knowledge of automotive will be gained from this hands-on course.

### Aspects to consider:

- Students gain SACE units and National Accreditation

- Students must be prepared to complete their study for 17 full day lessons (8 hours) throughout the year, conducted off campus in conjunction with the training provider
- Students develop independent learning skills
- Competency based assessment will take place in the workplace
- 20 days of work placement are required and will occur during the school holidays
- Compulsory attendance is required on VTECH training days
- Students will be required to supply their own safety shoes/boots (steel capped), safety glasses, overalls, riggers gloves, exercise books, diary and pens
