Get your P's and so much more... This engaging and interactive course delivers professional high-quality driver training, together with a theory program designed to increase awareness of road safety issues and instil a culture of safe driving – for life.

Our driver education course delivers a comprehensive educational program in addition to the standard driver licensing process, for a similar investment. Topics included, in addition to the driver's licence, are:

- driving attitudes and risk factors (peer groups, risk taking, distractions, drugs/alcohol)
- physics related to driving, – e.g. braking distances, speed, impact forces, reaction times
- vehicle safety inspection / preventative maintenance
- what to do in the event of breakdowns/emergencies
- hazards and characteristics of various vehicles (4wd, trucks, motorcycles, bicycles, buses)
- what to look for when purchasing the first vehicle
- minimising the environmental impact of driving

This road safety awareness training is reinforced as the student is equipped with the practical and defensive driving skills (behind the wheel) to stay safe on the roads. The practical driving component of the course will be facilitated on a 2-to-1 basis by licensed and experienced Motor Driving Instructors in safely maintained, dual controlled, **automatic** vehicles.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain SACE credits as well as their driver's licence.
- **Students must hold a current Learner's Permit issued by the Department for Transport, Energy & Infrastructure.**
- Training in manual vehicle is available **outside** of this course at an additional cost. Please note that most students only require 2 additional lessons (at the conclusion of the course) to become competent in a manual vehicle.
- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week after school hours (1 hour lessons, 4pm-5pm) conducted by the Allan Miller Driving School.
- Driving lessons will be organised by Allan Miller Driving School subject to students availability
- **Driver training requires a partnership between parents/caregivers and professional instructors for training/practice & assessment. In this partnership parents/caregivers are expected to facilitate at least 2 hours per week of on-road driving practice to reinforce professional lessons.**
- Allan Miller Driving School provides an induction training session and on-going support for parents/caregivers. This induction/training session is compulsory and will be delivered prior to the commencement of the course.
- Additional training hours may be required, at additional cost, to achieve the licence competency standard.

Assessment:

In-vehicle components are assessed by authorised or accredited driving instructors against Department for Transport, Energy and Infrastructure requirements. Theory assessment is via written tasks and classroom activities. Some homework tasks will be assigned to reinforce learning in classroom-based workshops.
