EVENT MANAGEMENT - MUSIC

"How To Organise Your Own Music Event"

Available to: Yrs 10, 11 and 12
Length: 1 semester (15 weeks)
Accreditation: 2 SACE Units

Good management of events is a crucial ingredient for their success. This unit covers the principles of good management. You will be expected to organise, under minimal supervision, a local event.

Students will design and deliver a music event. The type of music event, including the venue, will be decided upon and organised by the students as a group.

An interest in Event Management and/or the music industry is desirable.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain credit towards National Accredited Competencies
- Genuine interest in Event Management
- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week after school hours
Instruction lesson (3 hours) conducted off campus in conjunction with the Partnership schools
- There are no formal prerequisites for this module
