FIBRE FASHION AND COLOUR

Partial Certificate II in Visual Arts & Contemporary Crafts

Available to:	Years 10, 11 and 12
Length:	1 semester (16 weeks)
Accreditation:	15 SACE Credits – Stage 1 (30 SACE Credits – Full Year)

Interested in creating your own colourful fabric designs for personalising your clothing? This course will introduce you to the skills of dyeing cotton material and printing on fabric. You will use the fashion design process to create unique dyed / printed articles of clothing by either making your own or using pre-made garments.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain SACE credits and National Accreditation
- Genuine interest in developing skills in the creative textile arts / fashion industry
- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week in after school hour instruction lessons (3 hours) conducted off campus in conjunction with member schools
- Additional 3 hours of homework activities
- No previous experience required
- Additional materials will need to be purchased
- Access to a sewing machine is beneficial but not essential
- Cost (see your VET Coordinator)

Content:

Semester 1

➤ CUVVSP54B	Apply techniques to produce textile/fibre work (dyeing)	50 hours
➤ CUVVSP44B	Apply techniques to produce prints	50 hours
➤ CUVCRS08B	Document the work progress	15 hours

Students can continue this course and complete further competencies in Semester 2

Content: Semester 2

How do fashion designers find their inspirations and ideas? How do they use drawings, mood boards and embellishment skills to create unique designs? This course introduces and discusses these aspects and includes the skills of hand and free machine embroidery, applique and beading. Students will apply these skills to their own pre-made garments and / or accessories to produce unique pieces of personalised wearable art.

➤ CUVVSP55B	Produce textile/fibre work (appliqué, beading, embellishment)	50 hours
➤ CUVVSP14B	Apply techniques to produce drawings (hand and free machine embroidery)	50 hours
➤ CUVCRS13B	Store finished work	15 hours

Assessment: 1 or 2 finished project pieces and a completed folder for each unit
