Do you love meeting new people? Are you creative and want to learn new skills? Would you like to work in the fashion industry? Do you want a career that allows you to travel? Perhaps hairdressing is a good career choice for you.

Certificate II in an entry-level program in the hairdressing industry. All modules are conducted on premises and students work in a salon environment and learn skills that will help them integrate into the industry. There is a constant demand for well-trained hairdressers and Certificate II is a great pathway to an apprenticeship.

This course provides students who want a career in hairdressing with valuable insight into the profession. The work placement component of the course has provided a pathway to apprenticeships for many students. Employers contact the academy when looking for apprentices and, through the work experience program; the academy is able to connect the two to gauge suitability for employment for both sides.

Certificate II in Hairdressing is a qualification that teaches the skills needed to become a Hairdressing Salon Assistant. The focus of the training is to learn valuable skills for working and assisting qualified hairdressers in a salon environment. Following are some of the skills that students will learn: head, shoulder & scalp massage; shampoo hair like the professionals; blow-dry long hair; set & blow-dry short hair; creative styling; braiding & creative long hair up-styling and basic colour application & removal.

Clip Joint Education has strong professional ties to the hairdressing industry and was inducted into SA Hair & Beauty Industry Association Hall of Fame; an honour awarded by industry votes. Finalists in the 2010 Schwartzkopf "Education Organisation of the Year" and the 2010 Telstra MYOB Small Business Award "RTO Award for Excellence in the Delivery of Student Pathways". These awards are a reflection of the respect the Clip Joint name holds in SA hairdressing.

- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week for a full day lesson (9.00am – 3.30pm, excluding school holidays) conducted off campus

- Students work in a salon style environment to learn to become proficient as a Salon Assistant
- All modules are conducted on premises at Clip Joint Academy
- If you are under 18, you will be required to have a parent/guardian present at any formal appointment
