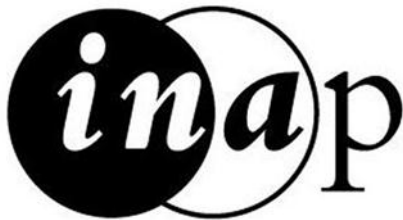

The work placement component of the course has provided a pathway to apprenticeships for many students. Employers contact the academy when looking for apprentices and, through the work experience program, the academy is able to connect the two to gauge suitability for employment for both sides.

Certificate II in Hairdressing is a qualification that teaches the skills needed to become a Hairdressing Salon Assistant. The focus of the training is to learn valuable skills for working and assisting qualified hairdressers in a salon environment.
