The Certificate II in Hospitality is designed to reflect the role of hospitality employees who perform a range of activities and functions requiring basic operational knowledge and limited practical skills within a hospitality food and beverage operation.

Students must be turning 17 prior to the conclusion of the class or currently completing year 12.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain SACE units
- A step towards the Certificate III in Hospitality – Top Up or Certificate IV in Hospitality – Food and Beverage
- Students must be prepared to complete their study over five days **during the school holidays** (9am -3pm), conducted off campus
- Students will develop independent learning skills
- Students learn through applying a “hands-on” approach
- Site Academy shirt is to be worn with black pants, black leather enclosed shoes and black socks (no anklets). Please wear a plain black shirt if you do not have one from Site Academy.
- Prerequisite: SIT10207 – Certificate I in Hospitality
