

Available to: Years 10, 11 & 12
Length: 1 Semester (16 weeks)

The Certificate I in Hospitality is designed to reflect the role of entry level employees who perform routine tasks under direct supervision in a hospitality food and beverage operation.

Students who complete the courseware will be able to confidently apply for the following positions knowing that they have the skills, knowledge and work experience to meet the requirements of the position: waiting staff in a café, restaurant or unlicensed venue, barista, functions/convention runner, functions set up, 'Glassie' in a licensed venue, counter assistant in a franchise outlet.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain SACE units
- A step towards the Certificate II in Hospitality – Food and Beverage, Certificate II in Tourism - Events
- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week, **during school hours** (8.30am -12.15pm or 12:45pm – 4:30pm) conducted off campus
- Students will develop independent learning skills
- Students learn through applying a "hands-on" approach
- Site Academy shirt provided during the second or third lesson is to be accompanied with black pants, black leather enclosed shoes, black socks (no anklets). Please wear a plain black shirt to first two lessons.
