The study of photography as an art form provides students with the opportunity to develop their creativity and imagination. The work of photographers in the visual arts includes traditional and contemporary forms. Through their work photographers record both events and experiences and present a diverse array of concepts and opinions.

This subject is especially for the novice who owns (or will own) a 35mm camera and wishes to learn how to operate it. Students will learn about all basic camera functions and how to develop and print 35mm black and white film.

Some of the topics that may be covered during this course include:

Cameras, lenses, shutter speeds and f-stops, correct exposures, film processing and chemistry, contact sheets and enlarging, test strips and print controls, dodging, burning, and photographic retouching.

Aspects to Consider:

- Students gain a SACE credits and National Accreditation
- Genuine interest in developing skills in the Photographic Industry
- Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week after school hours (3 hours) conducted off campus with the partnership schools
- Students will develop independent learning skills
- An introduction to Black and White film photography
- How to use a manual 35mm S.L.R camera and accessories
- How to process Black and White film
- How to produce a quality Black and White print
- To produce a quality photographic essay
- Competency based assessments will take place in the workplace
- Cameras can be provided if booked in advance, but it is preferable if students bring their own manual 35mm S.L.R camera (please note there will be a weekly camera hire fee)
- Please bring: book for recording notes and a snap ring binder with sleeves
