

# Massage Pathways

After completing the Advanced Diploma you may apply to University to undertake a Bachelor Degree in Complementary Medicine

## Master Therapist

### Massage Therapist – Cert IV in Massage 6 months Training

At this level you can set up your own clinic, work for day spas, or do corporate massage under supervision. Cert IV is considered by the Massage industry as the basic entry level into the profession.

### Remedial Massage Therapist – Diploma of Remedial Massage 12 months Training

This level has been designed so you may work alongside other health professionals, in either a professional clinic, sporting institution, or as a fully independent practitioner, responsible for your own clinic. You will be eligible to apply for health fund provider numbers so that your clients may claim services from their private health fund.

### Musculoskeletal Therapist – Advanced Diploma of Musculoskeletal Therapy 24 months training

At this level you will have been trained to a very high standard and be able to work as a respected practitioner in Medical clinics or with Chiropractors, Physiotherapists or Podiatrist. You will be conversant with sport medicine and be able to treat athletes or sports people at an elite level.

**VET in schools course – Massage for Sport & Fitness** - part of the Diploma of Remedial Massage, which can be credited towards the Cert IV in Massage
