This exciting course is designed to offer the basic skills to becoming an MC (Master of Ceremonies) through personal presentation and communication. MC's are becoming popular to host social events, weddings, formals and functions, at nightclubs and dance functions working with DJ's, for community events and even in radio.

This course is based on the accredited course 'English Proficiency' and includes creative thinking, oral expression, presentation skills, planning and decision-making. Student's will develop greater self-confidence, improve their oral expression and in relating to others.
