Certificate II is a qualification that teaches the elementary skills needed to become a "Cosmetic Retail Sales Consultant and Make-up Artist". This is an entry-level program into the beauty industry. Students learn the essential techniques of make-up artistry to allow them to work in a cosmetic retail environment or freelance work. Clip Joint has strong professional ties with Napoleon Perdis as well as the hairdressing industry.

The focus of training is to learn valuable skills for working in the make-up industry. Skills such as skin preparation, analysing face and eye shapes, contouring and highlighting, make-up selection and tools of the trade, colour theory and make-up designs, false eyelash application, day/evening make-up, bridal, formal, exotic and photographic make-up as well as demonstrating and recommending retail cosmetic products are some of the skills students will learn throughout this course.

- During the course you will be required to be available for **work experience**, which may include weekend and / or evening work. **A minimum of 10 contact hours in a retail environment is required**
- Students develop independent learning skills
- Note. If you are under 18 years of age, you will be required to have a parent/guardian present at any formal appointment (e.g. signing of documentation).
