PROVIDE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL - TIME

This course provides participants with the skills and knowledge to satisfy the requirements for responsible service of alcohol under State/Territory legislation.

All elements are undertaken in accordance with legal provisions of the relevant liquor legislation and gives accreditation to be a responsible person in a licensed venue. Students will understand the responsible practices that must be undertaken wherever alcohol is served and sold, including on-site product tastings.

Skills learnt include:

- ❖ Sale and service of alcohol
- ❖ Identifying customers to whom service may be refused
- ❖ Prepare and serve alcoholic beverages responsibly
- ❖ Assisting customers to drink within appropriate limits
- ❖ Assisting alcohol affected customers
- ❖ Understanding the factors that affect individual responses to alcohol and the effects of alcohol on the emotional state, health and physical alertness

Successful completion of the course will provide participants with the unit of competency,
