This course is an introduction to basic photo manipulation/creation and multimedia software. Different techniques for manipulating photos are taught, including black and white, sepia, collages and much more. Design aspect of creating websites will be discussed, including the navigation, interface and web standards. The outcomes are a website to display the created photos along with a portfolio of printed photos.

Aspects to consider:

- Students gain a SACE unit and National Accreditation
- Genuine interest in Multimedia
- Students must be prepared to complete their study on a once a week after school hours instruction lesson (3 hours) conducted off campus in conjunction with the partnership schools
- Using computers for multimedia and photo manipulation
- Competency based assessment will take place
- Cost (see your VET Coordinator)

Content:

The overall plan is to come up with a portfolio of photos (created and manipulated) and will include some techniques used in professional petrography (ie Modelling). Students wishing to complete the Graphic Design component of the course, students can enrol in this for in Semester 1, 2011.

The overall plan is to produce a portfolio (printed) of photos and also a screen presentation.
